

India, too, has seen a decline in several tribal languages due to modernization and Celebrating Languages migration. Day becomes an act of resistance, a way to rekindle pride in linguistic roots and educate students about the fragility of these vulnerable treasures.

Aligned with India's National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 which prioritizes mother-tongue education for holistic student development, department's initiatives emphasize multilingualism the foundation as intellectual growth and emotional well-being. Languages Day accentuates this philosophy by creating space where students engage with their native languages through inspiring discussions and counter the notion that regional languages are "less relevant" in modern contexts.
