WinSCP User Guide

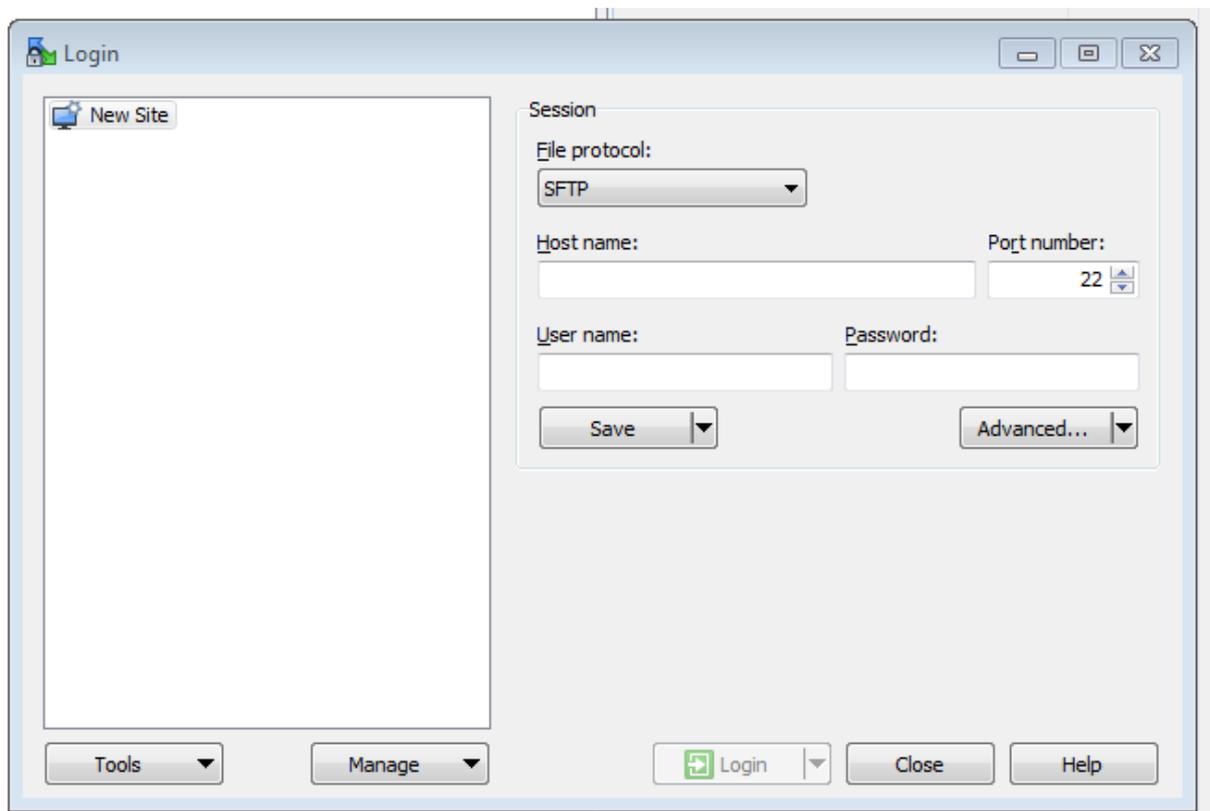
WinSCP is an open source free **SFTP client**, **FTP client**, **WebDAV** client and **SCP** client for Windows. Its main function is file transfer between a local and a remote computer.

Download – WinSCP from

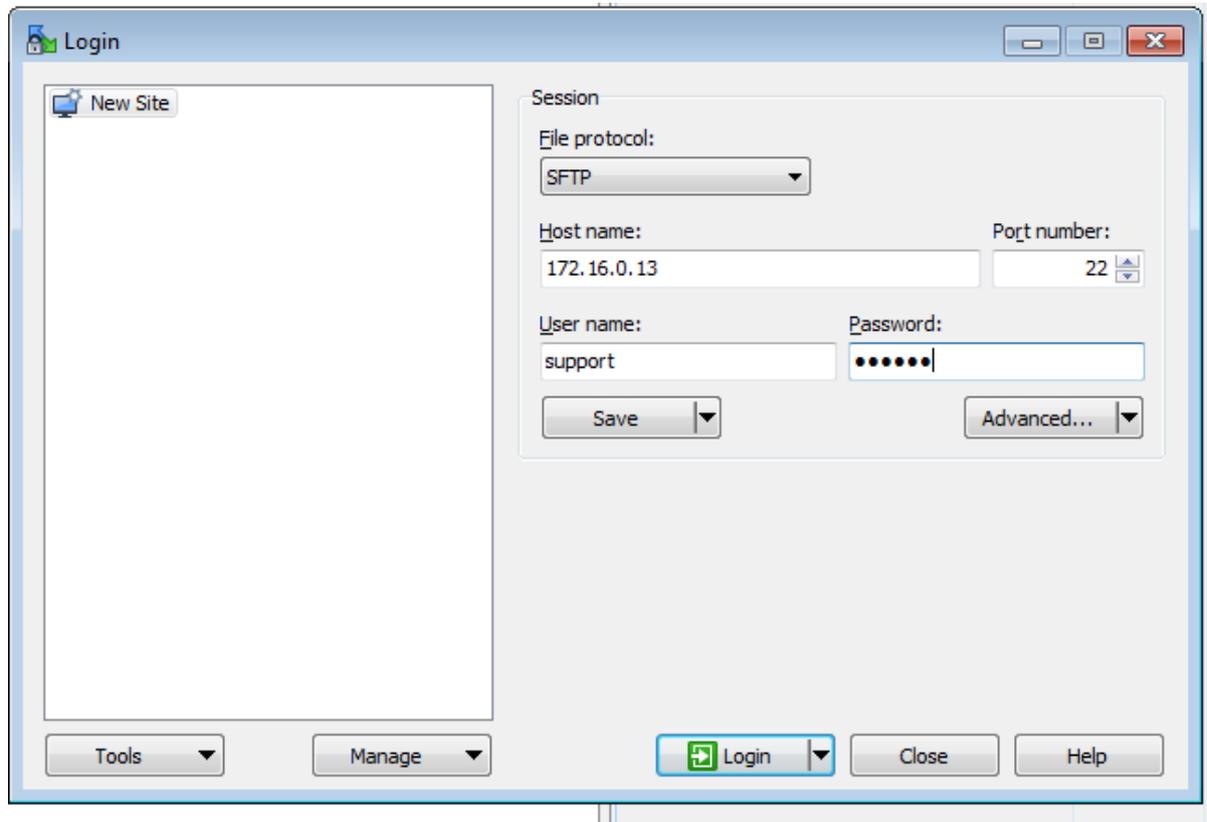
After installing, run the WinSCP application.

You will be prompted for hostname and username and password

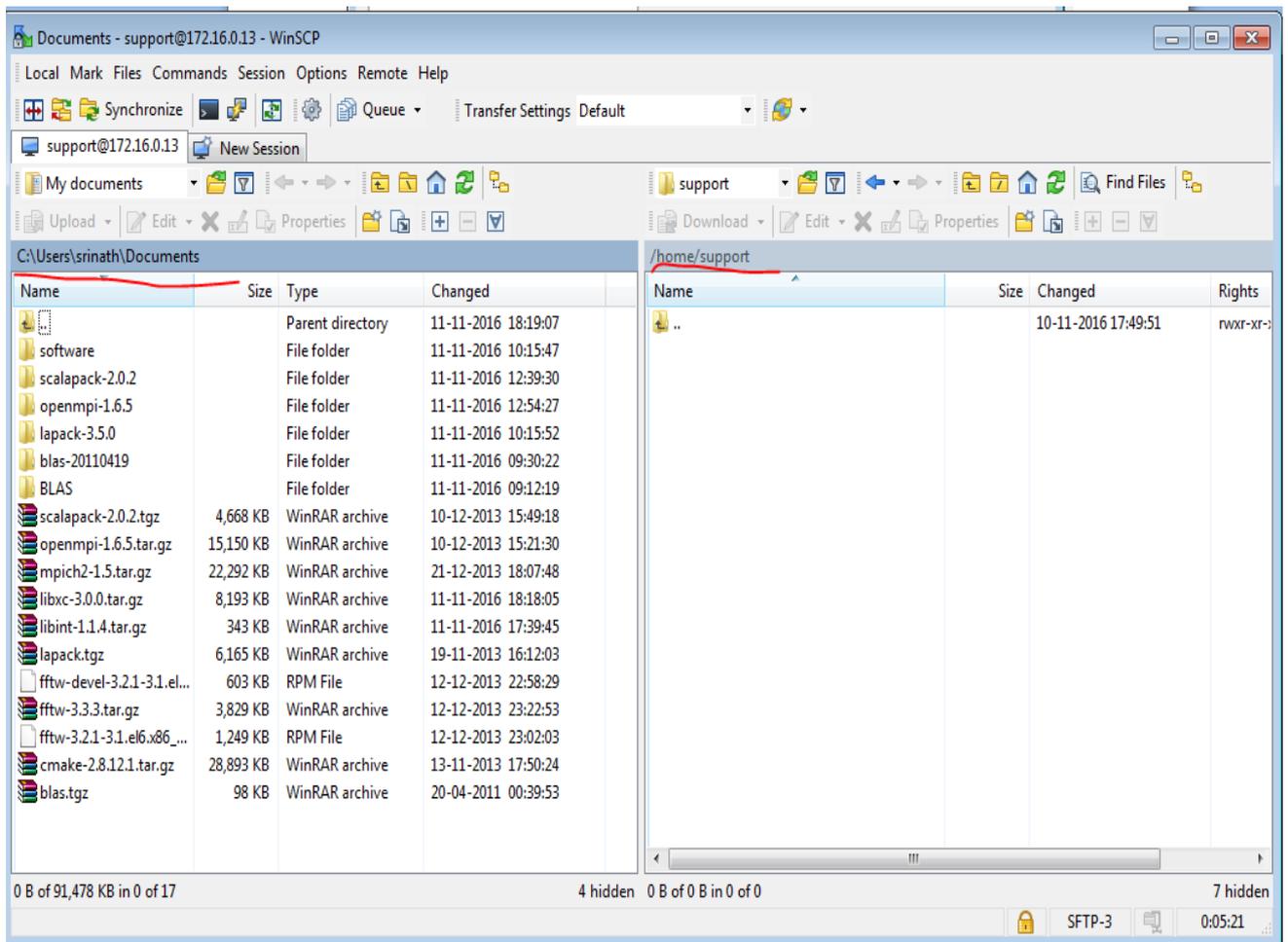


NOTE: file protocol is SFTP

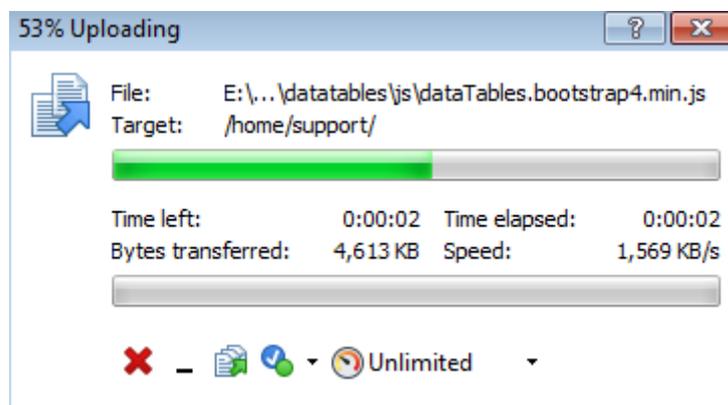
Please enter the Hostname, user name and password and click login



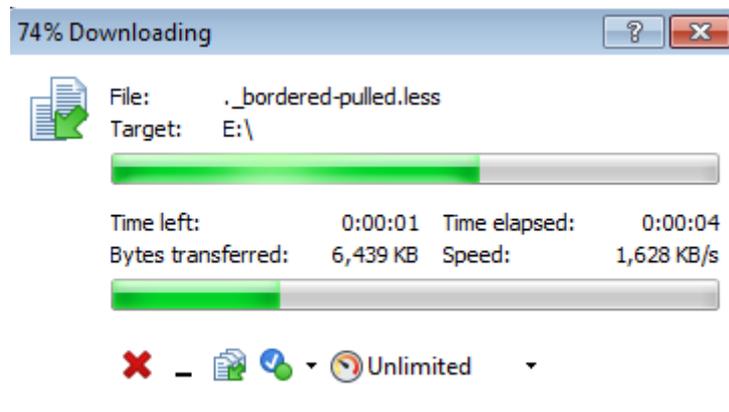
Once you successfully login you will see a connection window with two screens the left window is your local computer right window is remote computer



You can drag and drop the files from your local computer to remote computer. If you drag the files from your **local computer to remote computer** then you will see the uploading window.



Same way you can drag and drop the files from **remote computer to local computer** then you will see the downloading window.



You can delete the unwanted files in remote computer by selecting the folder in right side window and press the symbol (X).

Then you will be prompted for below conformation window press ok.
