Early diagnosis of fungal infection is critical for effective treatment. In addition, fungal diagnostics must meet the contrasting needs presented by the increasing diversity of fungi found in association with the use of immunosuppressive agents in countries with high levels of medical care and the need for diagnostics in resource-limited countries. Traditional approaches to diagnosis include direct microscopic examination of clinical samples, histopathology, culture, and serology.

Diagnosis of invasive fungal infections are challenging due to adaptation of conventional diagnosis method which are time consuming, yielding delayed results and delayed treatment. Such limitations have consequences; delayed diagnosis leads to delayed treatment. Emerging technologies include molecular diagnostics and antigen detection in clinical samples. Innovative new technologies that use molecular and immunoassay platforms have the potential to meet the needs of both resource-rich and resource-limited clinical environments.

Most hospitals do not perform mycological examinations because laboratory personnel still believe in the "old wives' tale" that mycology is too difficult to do and that the fungi are too infectious to handle. This National Workshop cum Conference organized by Department of Microbiology, SRM Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, SRM IST, Kattankulathur, Chennai, presents methods suitable for use in laboratories of all sizes.
