The students who are selected for this programme willcarry out research in SRM as well as in Shizuoka University. On the successful completion of this program, students will be awarded PhD degree from both the Universities. - DDP exchange candidates must clear the DDP screening examination hosted on the internet by Shizuoka University, Japan.
- DDP is a 5 years doctoral program. Students enrolling with SRM University for PhD will complete 2 years of study at SRM University and later continue research in Shizuoka University for 3 years.
- DDP exchange students will be required to submit different doctoral dissertations to SRM University and Shizuoka University.
- DDP exchange students who passed their examinations will receive Doctor of Engg (D.Eng.), Doctor of Informatics (D.Inf.), Doctor of Science (D. Sci.), Doctor of Agriculture (D.Agr.) or Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) degree from Shizuoka University and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) from SRM University.
