### Teaching / Research Assistantships

- Masters /Graduate aid consists of Teaching / Research Assistantships.
- Teaching / Research Assistants gain valuable experience by assisting faculty members with instruction in undergraduate courses / research projects, staffing the programs and research Centers, within the School.
- Teaching / Research Assistantships must be applied annually and are awarded on the basis of academic merit.
- The selection of Teaching Assistantships is thus highly competitive. Decisions concerning Teaching Assistantships are made by the respective School.
- The University requires Teaching / Research Assistants to enroll for each semester and to work fifteen hours each week.
- Teaching / Research Assistantships normally carry a modest monthly stipend. Precise terms of compensation will be specified in the letter of offer awarding a Teaching / Research Assistantship.
- Teaching / Research Assistants are not allowed to accept outside employment. Failure to meet these requirements may result in loss of the Assistantship.
