Under 2018 Regulations of Faculty of Engineering and Technology, the students are being given a Grade Card at the end of each semester, containing the following letter grades with the Credit points as indicated:

The SGPA (Semester Grade Point Average) is given at the end of each semester. Also, CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of each semester taking into account the Grades and Credits earned by the student in the courses from the first semester up to the last semester of appearance.

The Final CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of the programme, taking into account the Grades and credits earned by the student in all the courses of Undergraduate / Postgraduate Degree Programme. The overall performance of a student is indicated by the CGPA on a 10 point scale. This is approximately equivalent to CGPA multiplied by 10 on a scale of '0' to '100' marks.

The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is calculated by considering all the courses taken from the first semester onwards for regular students (for UG & PG) and from third semester onwards for lateral entry students for UG Degree.
