Under 2021 Regulations of Faculty of Engineering and Technology, the students are being given a Grade card at the end of each semester, containing the following letter grades with the Grade points as indicated.

F – Failure due to insufficient Marks, I – Failure due to insufficient attendance, Ab – Failure due to Non-Appearance in the Examination.

The SGPA (Semester Grade Point Average) is given for each semester. Also, the CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given in at the end of each semester taking into account the Grades and the Credits earned by the student in the courses up to that semester (From First Semester for UG and PG).

The Final CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of the programme taking into account the Grades and the Credits earned by the student in all the courses in all the courses of the Degree Programme. The overall performance of the student is indicated by the CGPA on a 10 point scale. This is approximately equivalent to CGPA multiplied by 10 on a scale of '0' to '100' marks.

The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is calculated by considering all the courses taken from the first semester onwards for regular students (for UG & PG) and from third semester onwards for lateral entry students for UG Degree.
