







25th April'22: Sculpt your Ideas, Mr. Saravana Raja R from Design Department, SAID

The workshop was curated to render hands on modelling for the Students in the Design Stream. The learning of how to perceive a form and translating it into 3-dimensional model was the interesting part of the workshop. The students had creatively explored with different forms, their abstraction and surface modelling. The expert talk by Mr. Saravana Raja R, explained about the importance of modelling as a tool for design Ideation. The technique of pins with thread connections was used to build the model. The different surface modulations, depth with layers, expression of movement with the tension of the thread were explored creatively with the abstracted forms and objects by the students. It was a colourful event to see the outcome display of creative models handcrafted by the students from the Design Schools.


