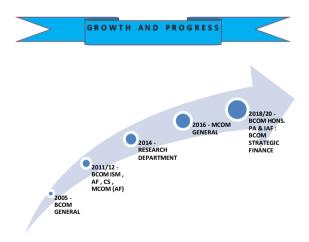

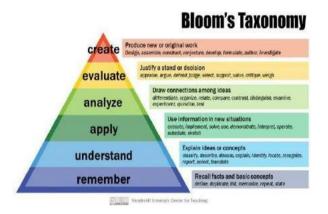

thinking, learning, and understanding. Educators have typically used Bloom's taxonomy to inform or guide the development of assessments curriculum and instructional methods such as questioning strategies



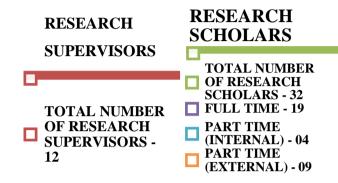
Research and Publications

their papers in Reputed Journals.

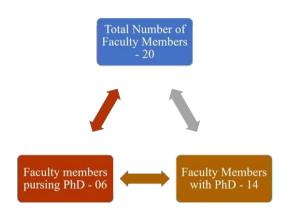
SRM JOURNAL OF BUSINESS HORIZONS: AN ANNUAL PUBLICATION OF DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

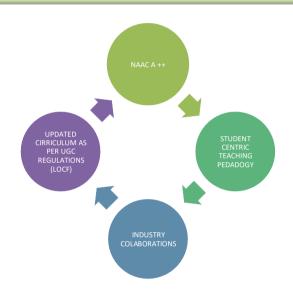

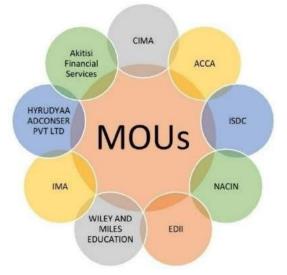

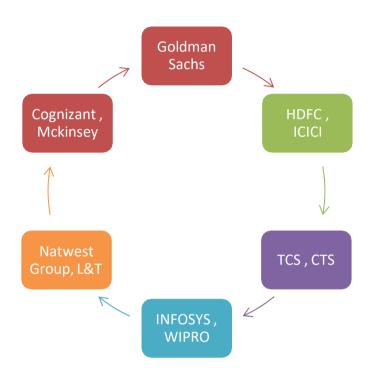
