SRM Crystal Growing Challenge and Quiz Contest 2022 (16 September, 2022)

SRM Crystal Growing Challenge 2022, the first of its kind, was conducted by the Department of Chemistry, SRMIST, Kattankulathur, to out-reach the high school (11th and 12th) students and UG students from the neighbourhood. The programme was also combined with a quiz contest exclusively for the high school students to make it more attractive. The programme was intended to attract potential students' community, and get to know more about SRMIST. There was no registration fee to participate in this programme. Prof. M. Arthanareeswari, HoD, Chemistry, was the convener, and the following faculty members were co-conveners: Dr. Goutam Kumar Kole, Dr. Venkatramaiah Nutalapati, Dr. Samarendra Maji, Dr. A. John Bosco, Dr. Ganesh Pandian, and Dr. Gopal Chandru Senadi. Three faculty members served as coordinators: Dr. Abhijit Saha, Dr. Dipankar Das, Dr. Rabindra Nath Das. Dr. J. Arockia Selvi, and Dr. Pushpa Malini, Dr. B. Natarajan, Dr. D. Paradesi helped the organising team in various ways.

About 111 students from 9 different high schools, 24 UG (Chemistry) students registered for the programme. The participating schools are: (i) Loyola Academy CBSE Senior Secondary School, Vadamelpakkam; (ii) Sree Gokulam Public School, Chengalpattu; (iii) Little Jacky Matric Higher Secondary School, Chengalpattu; (iv) Bharathiar School, Guduvanchery; (v) SRM Public School; Guduvanchery; (vi) JRK Global School, Kattankulathur; (vii) Lightworkers Academy, Nallambakkam; (viii) Sivananda Rajaram Senior Secondary School (CBSE), Maraimalai Nagar; (ix) Gurukulam Matric Higher Secondary School, West Tambaram. Students at the UG level participated from the following colleges: Dr. MGR Educational and Research Institute, Maduravoyal; D. G. Vaishnava College, Arumbakkam, Chennai; and our own Department of Chemistry, SRMIST, Kattankulathur.

In the morning, registration started at 9:00 am and students in a team of two members, displayed beautiful crystals of various commonly available chemicals, grown by themselves at their home institute, at the ground floor lobby at the University building. Innovative ideas of showcasing their crystals by the participants was commendable. The exhibition remained open for all to explore until 12:45 pm. Respected Dean CET, Dean Biotechnology, Dean Research, Director, Hotel Management, Associate director, campus-life, SRMIST are the dignitaries who graced the occasion of exhibition. All of them interacted with the young participants actively. We hope that the young students have been motivated and inspired by the valuable interaction with the dignitaries. A group of three-member judges inspected and interacted with the participants. Based on their evaluation, four teams were selected for prizes. The first prize was won jointly the teams of Bharathiar School, Guduvanchery (M. Duraimurugan, M. Jeevithan, S. Deepak, and H. Hasif Farhan); and Lightworkers Academy, Nallambakkam (D. Manish, and S. Meenatche Sri). The second prize went to the team of Loyola Academy CBSE Senior Secondary School, Vadamelpakkam (K. Sri Dharshan, and A. P.

Roshan Gershom). The third prize was won by team of SRM Public School; Guduvanchery (A. Rakshitha, and K. S. Bavithran).
