- Full film/part submitted previously to any other contest will not be considered for this contest. If found later, will be disqualified.


PHOTOGRAPHY







BND-O-WESTERN



COMPETITION GUIDELINES:

- Each entry should have participants from the same department of the respective institute.
- Negative marking will be given to the participants if they exceed the given time limit.
- Submission of soundtrack must be made in MP3 format on the day of registration before 11 am.
- The submitted digital files should be of supported format; if not, the entry will be disqualified.
- Only the shortlisted entries will be allowed to perform on the day of the event.
- The shortlisted entries will be intimated on 16th Feb'23.
- All participants must dress modestly. Offensive language, behaviour and vulgarities will not be tolerated.
- The content of the submissions should not hurt any religious or cultural sentiments.
- Decision made by the judges will be final and irrevocable.

SPORTS RULES AND REGULATION

- 1.Each student is allowed to Participate In 1 outdoor and 1 Indoor event list.
- 2. ID-Cards and Bonafide certificates must be produced at the time of registration and before the match.
- 3.Once the team list is submitted at the time of registration, no changes will be allowed.
- 4. All players should report 30 minutes before the scheduled time of competition.
- 5. Misconduct at any point will result in disqualification of the team from the tournament.
- 6. The decision of the Umpire/Referee will be considered final and in case of any dispute only the captain is permitted to discuss with the Umpire/Referee.
- 7. The first-aid kit will be provided by the organizing committee, SRM IST and organizing committee will not be responsible for any injuries or mishaps during the event.
- 8. The students should appear in sports attire.
- 9. Only 1 team per college can register, except table tennis and badminton.
- 10. Organising committee's decision will be final.

CRICKET:

- Team: 12 players (11 players + 1 Substitute).
- Overs: 10 overs.
- Maximum of 3 overs / bowler.
- Each team has to bring their own cricket bat.

THROWBALL AND VOLLEYBALL

• Team: 8 players = 7 players + 1 substitute.

FUTSAL:

• Team: 7 players = 5 players + 2 Substitute.

BASKET BALL:

• Team: 8 players = 5 players + 3 Substitute

BADMINTON:

- Badminton has to be registered as doubles.
- Players have to bring their own racquets.

TABLE TENNIS:

- Table tennis has to be registered as doubles.
- Players have to bring their own TT bats.
