Despite their name and colour, the gold medals presented to winners at the Olympic Games haven't been made from solid gold since 1912. The modern gold medals are made from sterling silver and feature just small quantities of the precious metal (the Rio 2016 versions were 1.34 percent gold).



Sixth seed plays down becoming most successful male player

Rafael Nadal described his Australian Open triumph as his greatest comeback after he recovered from two sets down against Daniil Medvedev to win a record-breaking 21st grand slam title.

Nadal defeated Medvedev, the second seed, 2-6, 6-7 (5), 6-4, 6-4, 7-5 in five hours and 24 minutes, the second longest grand slam final. It is the first time in Nadal's career he has come back from two sets down in a slam final and the Spaniard has now won at least two singles titles at all four grand slam tournaments.

"If we put everything together, the scenario, the momentum, what it means. Yeah, without a doubt probably have been the biggest comeback of my tennis career," said Nadal.

The 35-year-old was not certain to compete in Australia. He had not played for most of the previous six months due to a chronic foot injury that required surgery. Then his preparation was disrupted by Covid.



FIFA world cup 2022 : qatar opens up ticket for sale

FIFA World Cup 2022 is all set to be held at the end of the year, and Qatar opened up ticket sales for fans across the world. The World Cup is starting on November 21, 2022, with the final to be held on December 18, 2022. The almost month-long affair will be a great time for sports fans, and sports tourism is expected to thrive during that time. But of course, like much else in these unsure times, it all depends on the ongoing pandemic. Football fans and curious travelers can now start booking their tickets. It is being speculated that the starting price would be USD 70. On the other hand, for Qatar residents the cheapest ticket is going to be priced at USD 11 for a category four seating. However, the coveted final match of the Qatar World Cup 2022 should cost you around a whopping \$604 to \$1000. Compared to this year's Super Bowl that was priced at \$5950, this is pretty reasonable. Gaining entry to a match is not a straightforward process. It is being said that FIFA will distribute the tickets through a regulated process, and it will not be an open sale as one might imagine. The full range of prices are yet to be announced. There will be a random draw at the conclusion of the first application phase, which is going to go on until February 8. When you visit the official website of FIFA 2022, you will find two options. One that says International, and the other that is for Qatar residents. This will direct you to another page where, as per our personal experience, there is a rush, and you will have to wait and be in an on-line queue. Moreover, it is taking quite a bit of time to load the page. It's the FIFA World Cup after all.
