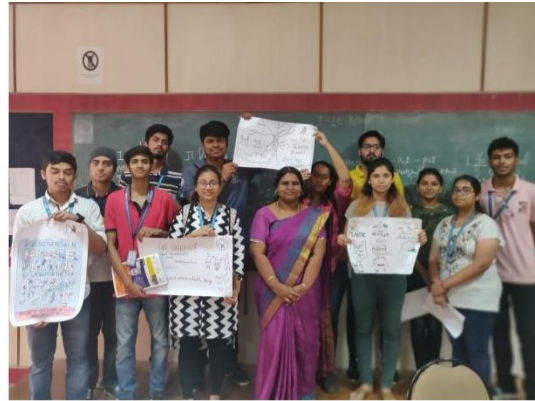

26. AWARENESS ON THE IMPORTANT OF HELMET

Riding a motorcycle gives riders a sense of freedom on the open road. However, there are serious dangers involved in riding without a helmet. A motorcycle does not provide the structural protection that a car does to keep drivers safe in the event of an accident. Motorcyclists need to take extra precautions to protect their body. The most important place to start is by protecting the head. It is important for motorcyclists to understand the risks of riding without a helmet. Riders who do not wear helmets are at risk of suffering a traumatic brain injury if they are in an accident. Without protection, the head is vulnerable to a traumatic impact in an accident even when traveling at low speeds.

Badly, there are few incidents took place within the campus also. Therefore, NSS planned to create awareness among our students, particularly all first year students dividing them in different groups for five days between 04-02-2019 and 08-02-2019 in different venues with the support from own experts from SRM Medical college hospital and research centre. This orientation on the importance of wearing helmet is given by Dr. Gireesh, Deputy Dean, SRMMCH&RC, with the direction of Dr. N. Sethuraman, The Registrar and Dr. C. Muthamizhchelvan, Director (Engg and Tech) and the guidance of Dr. Sundaram, Dean SRM Medical College Hospital. Faculty organized and accompanied the program were Mr. Senthilraja, Mr. Iniyan, Ms. Asha wise, Mrs. Parimalam, Mr. Muruganandam, Mr. Veeranath, along with Dr. T. Rajasekaran, NSS Program Coordinator.

Students attended and participated enthusiastically and seriously understanding the issues in not wearing helmet. All the students were administered pledge for wearing helmet and ensured their friends and others who are in their loop also wearing helmet.

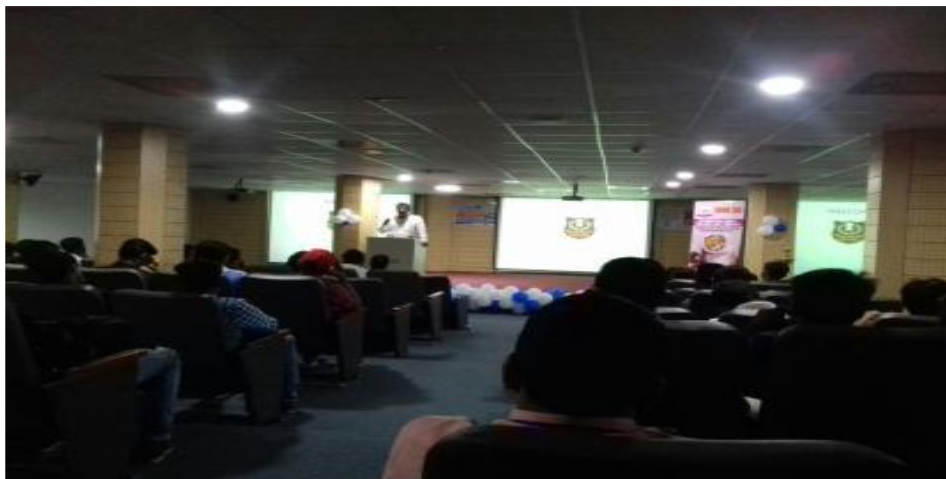
39. Traffic awareness

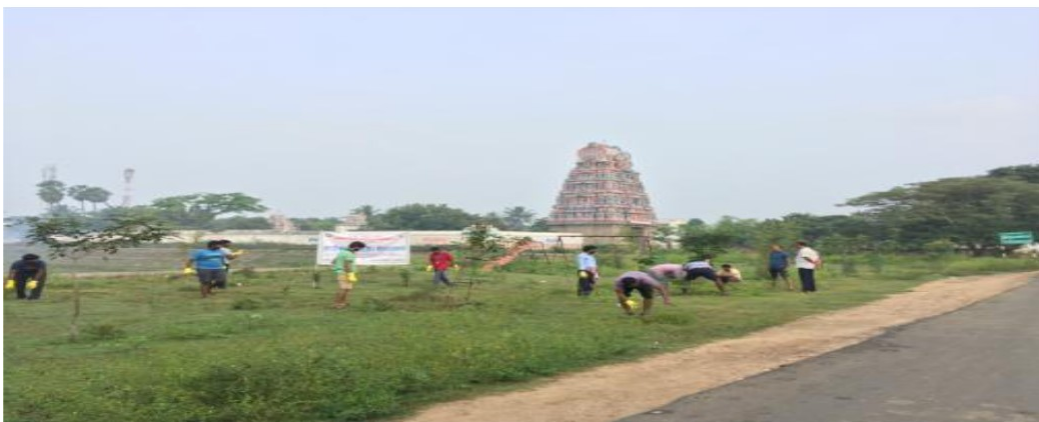
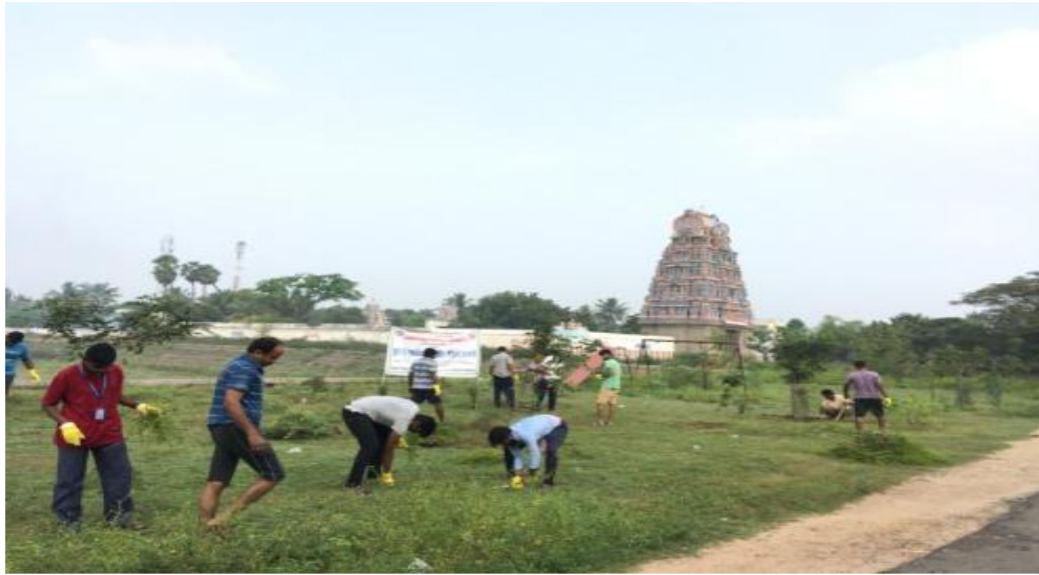
