



# CAMPUS-WISE PERFORMANCE OVER SRMIST – E&T - % OVER OR UNDER AVERAGE




# CAMPUS-WISE PERFORMANCE OVER SRMIST — S&H - % OVER OR UNDER AVERAGE




# CAMPUS-WISE PERFORMANCE OVER SRMIST – MGMT - % OVER OR UNDER AVERAGE

% OVER SRMIST AVERAGE -MGMT




# CAMPUS-WISE PERFORMANCE OVER SRMIST — DENTAL - % OVER OR UNDER AVERAGE

% OVER SRMIST AVERAGE -DENTAL




# MHS UNITS PERFORMANCE OVER SRMIST – % OVER OR UNDER AVERAGE
