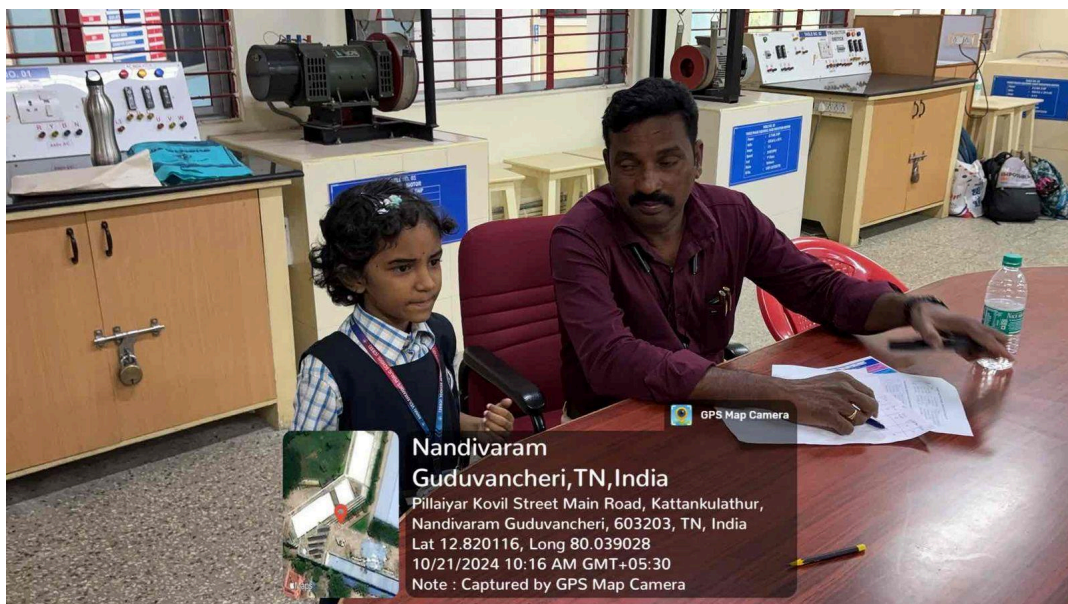


Essay & speech competitions in an importance of value education for school students was organized by SRMIST, EEE department in association with Universal human values at SRMIST on 21.10.2024.

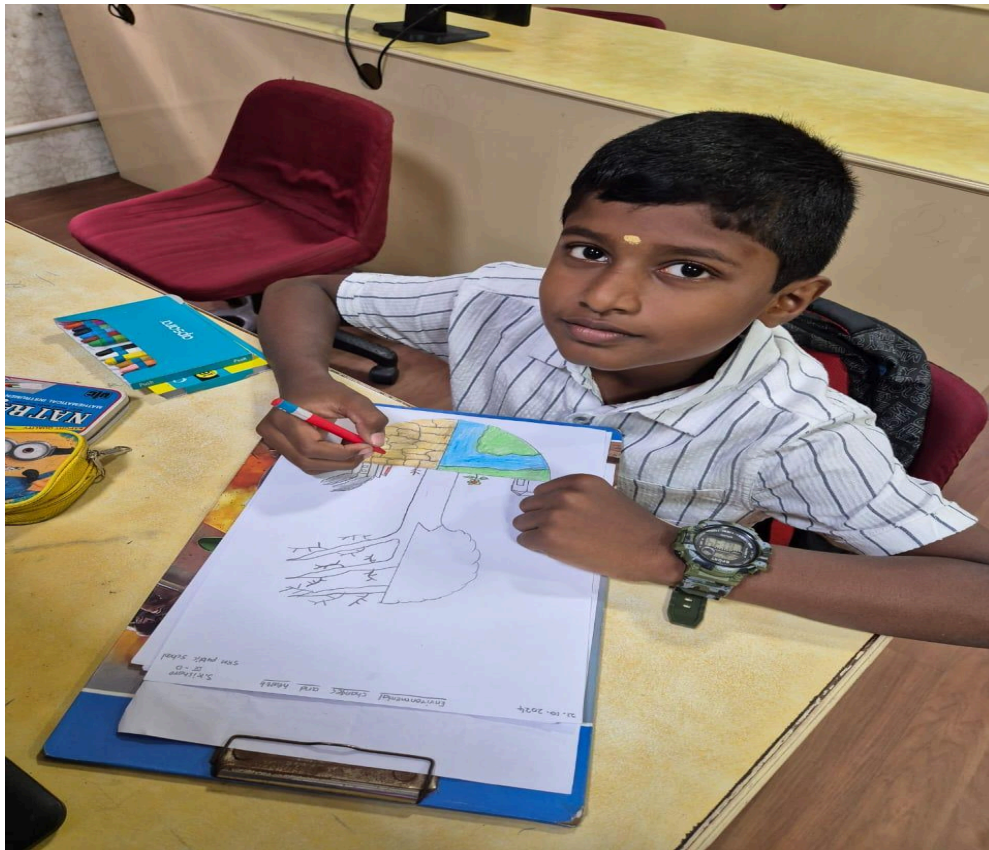
