"One Day Workshop on

Innovative Management for MSME's"

The Department of Chemistry at SRM Institute of Science and Technology (SRMIST) held a one-day workshop on "Innovative Management for MSMEs" on August 5, 2024. The event, hosted in Sir Vishveshvaraya Hall at the KTR Main Campus, began at 9:00 am and attracted industrial professionals, faculty, research scholars, and students. The workshop featured six expert speakers from industry and the Central Leather Research Institute (CLRI), who shared insights on innovative management strategies for Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in three sessions.

The first session of the workshop commenced with a welcome address by the convener Prof. M. Arthanareeswari, the Head of the Department, Chemistry, providing an overview of the

department's history, its academic achievements, and the various research opportunities available to students. The HoD emphasized the critical role of innovation in driving growth within MSMEs, particularly in the chemistry sector. The session highlighted the importance of intellectual property for Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises, offering practical guidance

on how to navigate the patenting process. Key topics included patent eligibility, application procedures, and strategies for leveraging patents to enhance business competitiveness. The lecture provided valuable insights, empowering participants with knowledge essential for protecting and capitalizing on their innovations with few interesting examples related to drug molecules patenting processes.

The session explored a range of financial support options provided by both the Tamil Nadu state government and the central

government. Key topics included various grants, subsidies, and loan schemes specifically designed for Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises. The lecture covered essential details such as eligibility

criteria, application processes, and offering participants a comprehensive overview of the resources available to them with few interesting examples or case studies. Additionally, practical tips were shared on how to successfully navigate the funding landscape, helping MSMEs leverage these opportunities to fuel growth, innovation, and competitiveness. The session was well-received, providing valuable information to businesses looking to expand and innovate with the support of government funding.

After a short tea break, the second session was started with the third invited talk delivered by Dr. A. ARAVIND, Assistant General Manager, Solara Active Pharma India Limited, Chennai-600127 on the title "Pharma Business from Short Term to Long Term". The session started off with the research works carried out by the speaker in the

area of hypertension during his postdoc and early career, then transitioned to strategies for evolving from short-term gains to long-term business sustainability. Key topics included the importance of continuous innovation, investment in research and development, and diversification of product lines to address broader market needs. The speaker emphasized the need for strategic planning, regulatory compliance, and building strong distribution networks to ensure sustained growth. Participants received practical advice on how to navigate the complexities of the pharma industry, including how to leverage initial successes to scale operations, expand market reach, and achieve long-term business objectives.

The fourth invited talk was delivered by Mr. VENKATESAN, Managing Director, ICA Specialties[p] Limited, Chennai-600096 on the topic "MSME Entrepreneurship Scenario in India". The lecture was started off by describing the expertise of ICA Specialties for over 35 years in the specialty inks, coatings, adhesives and sealants. The session also addressed key trends, challenges, and opportunities, along with government policies and support programs for entrepreneurs.

The session also covered fundraising options, such as bank loans, venture capital, and crowd funding, along with strategies for crafting a compelling business pitch. Emphasis was made on financial transparency, investor expectations, and scaling businesses effectively.

The sixth and the final invited talk was delivered by Dr. SUBHENDU CHAKRABARTHI Chief Scientist. Knowledge Portfolio Management Department (KPMD), **CSIR-Central Leather** Research Institute, Adyar, Chennai on the title "IP Enabled
