







#### **ALUMNI INTERACTION SERIES**

The 3 days Training of Trainers (TOT) program focused on simulation methodologies for nursing education. Experts in simulation method of teaching led the entire session. The sessions includes low to high fidelity simulation, simulated patients, props, high-fidelity simulators, tele simulation and advanced learning technologies. Day 1- Introduced basics, including the importance of simulation and adult learning principles. Day 2- Deliberated into scenario creation, prebriefing, and debriefing techniques. Day 3- Involved group activities, simulated scenarios, and discussions on challenges. Mentors guided participants through activities, ensuring effective learning. The program concluded with a valediction session, feedback submitted, certificate awarded to the participants and to resource person. Overall, TOT equipped trainers with essential skills to integrate simulation into teaching. Trainers gained insights into creating immersive learning experiences and facilitating effective debriefing. Collaboration among participants fostered engagement and knowledge sharing. The TOT program was a valuable opportunity for professional development in healthcare education.
