Objective of the Event:

The key objective of the Event was to

- To equip students with practical skills in data visualization and business intelligence using Power BI, which are highly valued in today's data-driven job market.
- To provide students with hands-on experience in working with real-world data, enabling them to create interactive dashboards, reports, and gain insights from data.
- To bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application by allowing students to apply what they have learned in their coursework to real-world scenarios using Power BI.

Brief Description about the Event:

On August 31, 2024, the Department of Computer Science at SRMIST, in collaboration with the department's student Club -Inferno, successfully organized a workshop titled "Real World Analytics – Solving Problems with Data." The workshop aimed to equip students with practical skills in data analysis using Power BI, a leading business intelligence tool.

The rollout for registration through google forms began on August 16, 2024, following the necessary approvals from the Officials of Faculty of Science and Humanities (FSH) at SRMIST. A nominal registration fee of INR 200 was collected from each participant. Both hard copy and e-certificates were provided to all attendees, ensuring they had tangible recognition for their efforts.

The workshop was led by Ms. Aaswin.R, an experienced data analyst currently working with Datayaan Pvt. Ltd. Known for her expertise and practical approach, Ms. Aaswin facilitated an interactive session, engaging participants with real-world data sets and guiding them through the process of creating insightful dashboards. Her ability to address individual queries with precision greatly enhanced the learning experience.




