8. Can I change my campus preference after the submission of my application?

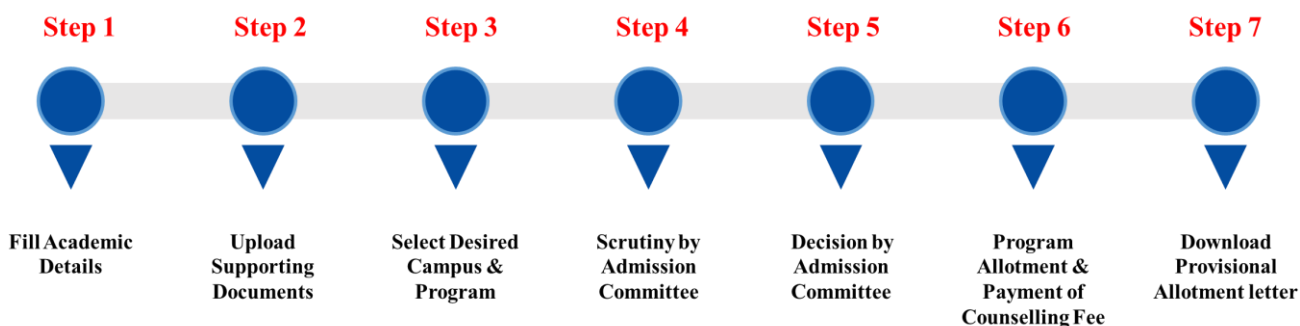
No, Candidates are expected to exercise caution when selecting the first preference of campus as they will be considered for admission to programs only in that particular campus.
