The GPA (Grade Point Average) is given for each semester. Also, the CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of each semester taking into account the Grades and the Credits earned by the student in the courses up to that semester (From First Semester for UG).

The Final CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of the programme taking into account the Grades and the credits earned by the student in all the courses of the Degree Programme. The overall performance of the student is indicated by the CGPA on a 10 point scale. This is approximately equivalent to CGPA multiplied by 10 on a scale of '0' to '100' marks.

The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is calculated by considering all the courses taken from the first semester onwards. \mathcal{L}
