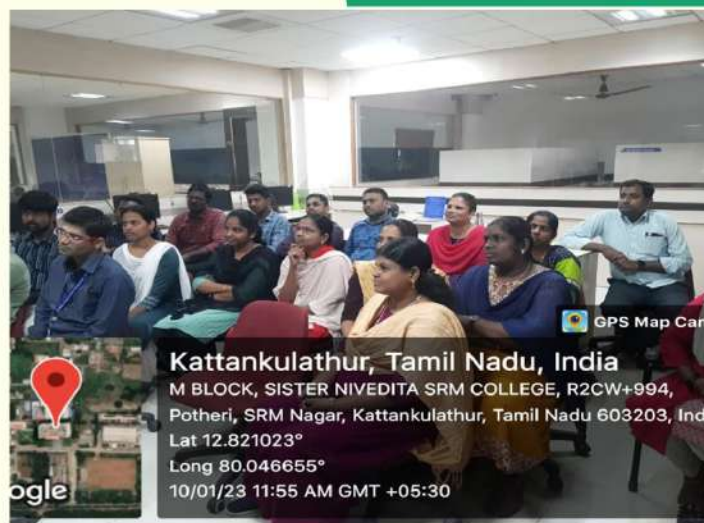
DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

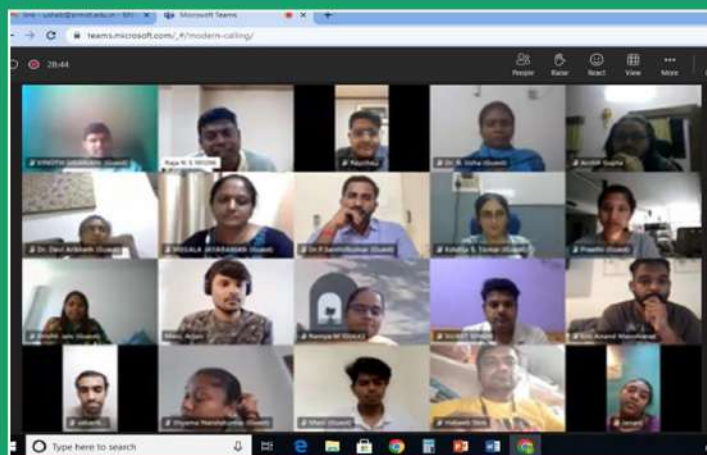
DEPARTMENT OF GENETIC ENGINEERING

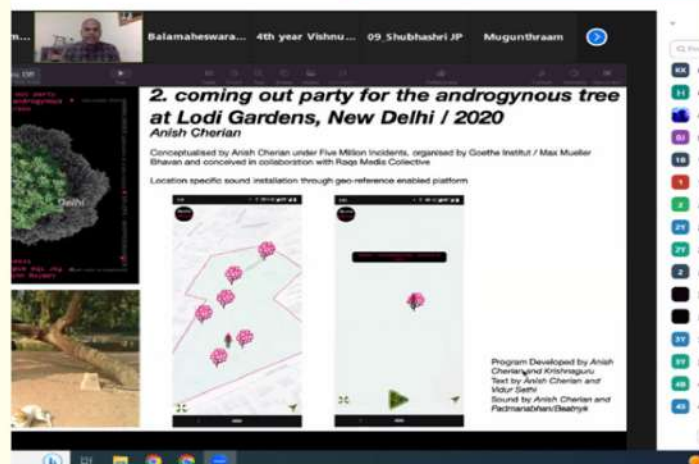

The Entrepreneurial Mind-set: Building a Culture of Innovation

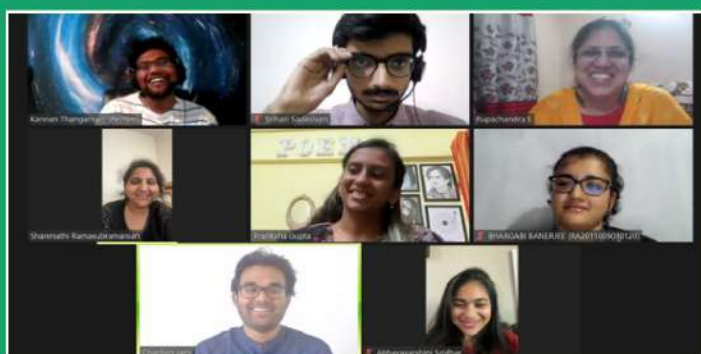

Mastering Digital Marketing

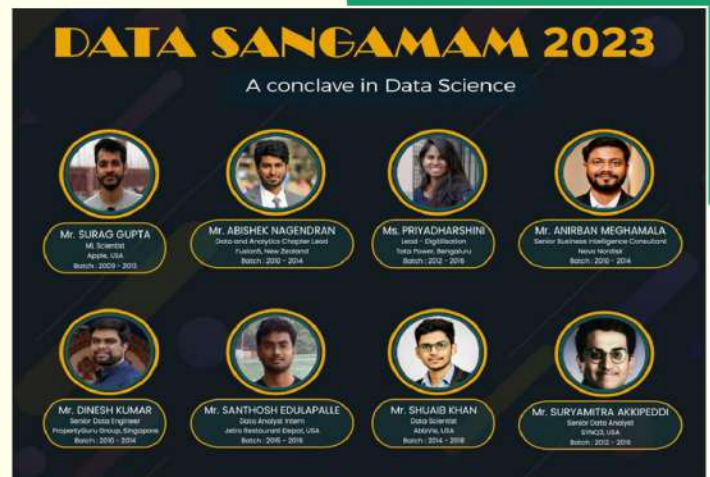

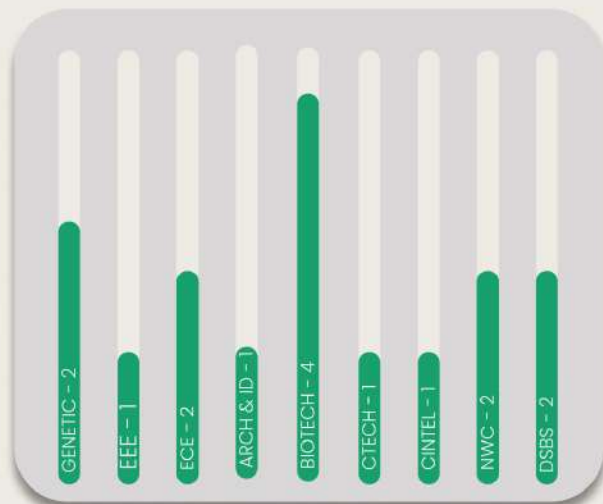
Data Sangamam 2023
