Report on the Training Programme on Mushroom Cultivation and Marketing

As part of the **Students' Project Implementation for Society**, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) - SRM Institute of Science and Technology (SRMIST), in collaboration with the **Department of Biotechnology, School of Bioengineering**, successfully conducted a **Training Programme on Mushroom Cultivation and Marketing** on **March 5, 2025**, at **Nattarasanpattu Community Hall**. This initiative was aimed at empowering local **Women Self-Help Groups (SHGs)** and the **youth** by providing hands-on training in **mushroom cultivation, spawn preparation, bed preparation, inoculation, harvesting, and marketing strategies**.

The key objective of this training programme was to introduce **sustainable bio-based entrepreneurial opportunities** to the rural community. By leveraging locally available resources and scientific techniques, the initiative focused on **skill development, self-employment, and economic sustainability**, aligning with the goals of the **Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, Viksit Bharat**, and **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**.

Participation and Engagement

A total of **30 participants**, including members of **Women Self-Help Groups (SHGs)** and **young entrepreneurs**, actively engaged in the programme. The interactive sessions facilitated knowledge-sharing and discussion on potential challenges and opportunities in the field of **mushroom-based agribusiness**.

Programme Highlights

Hands-on Training Sessions

Participants received in-depth **practical exposure** to various aspects of mushroom cultivation, including:

- **Spawn preparation** – Understanding the fundamentals of producing high-quality mushroom spawn.
- **Mushroom bed preparation** – Learning about different substrates, their preparation, and maintenance.
- **Inoculation process** – Techniques for ensuring optimal growth conditions.
- **Harvesting** – Identifying the correct time and method for harvesting to maximize yield.

Economic and Marketing Insights

Alongside technical skills, the programme also emphasized the **economic aspects of mushroom farming**, covering:

- **Cost analysis and investment planning**
- **Marketing strategies for rural entrepreneurs**
- **Supply chain and value addition opportunities**

This session helped participants understand how to build **sustainable and profitable business models** for mushroom cultivation.

Support and Facilitation

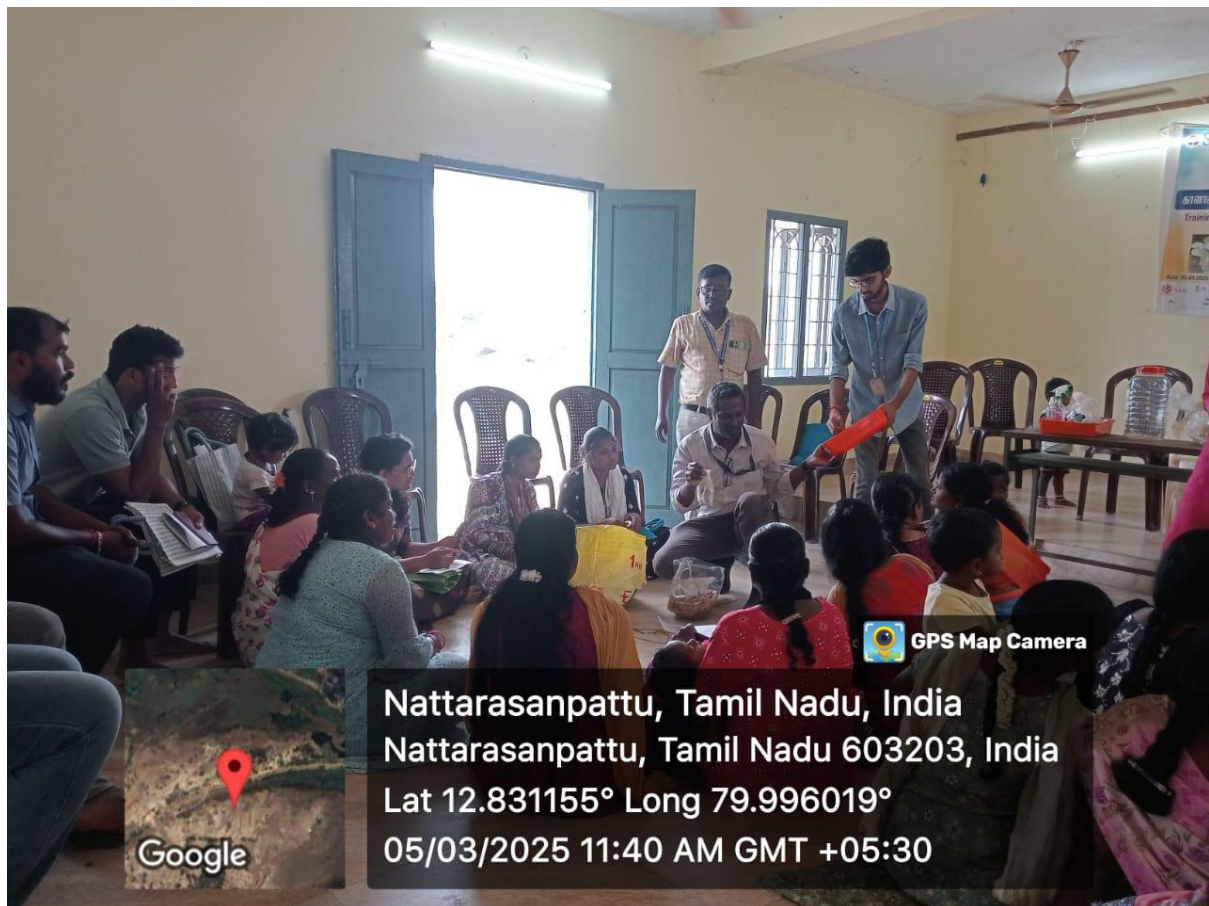
