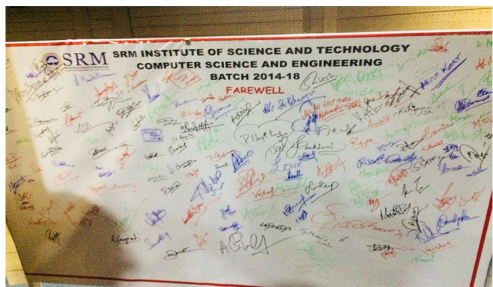

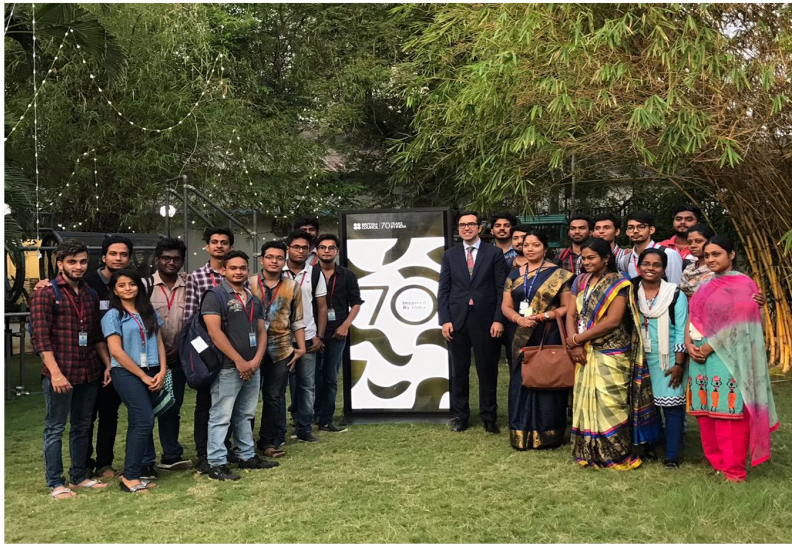

The function came to a conclusion by the vote of thanks proposed by Dr.C.Gomathy, head of the department of Electronics and Communications Engineering.



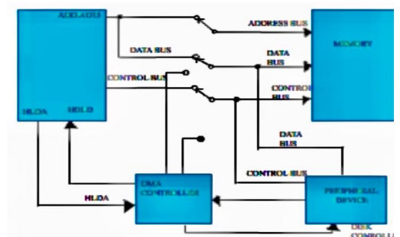
Technical Advancement - eLearn

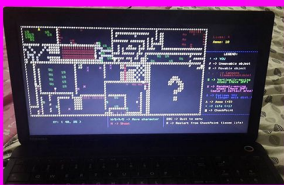
