SRM Institute of Science and Technology, Kattankulathur – 603 203 introduced the Credit System of Evaluation for Faculty of Engineering and Technology for awarding Letter Grades under 2004 Regulations for Undergraduate Programmes. Under 2004 Regulations, the students are given a Grade Sheet at the end of each semester, containing the following letter grades with the Credit points as indicated.

The GPA (Grade Point Average) is given for each semester. Also the CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of each semester taking into account the Grades and the Credits earned by the student in the courses up to that semester (from Third Semester for UG).

The Final CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of the programme taking into account the Grades and credits earned by the students in all the courses from Third Semester for Undergraduate Degree Programme (B.Tech) under 2004 Regulations. The overall performance of the student is indicated by the CGPA on a 10 point scale. This is approximately equivalent to CGPA multiplied by 10 on a scale of '0' to '100' marks.

❖ CGPA is calculated from 3rd Semester onwards for Undergraduate Programmes.
