SRM Institute of Science and Technology, Kattankulathur – 603 203 introduced the Choice Based Credit System of Evaluation for Faculty of Engineering and Technology for awarding Letter Grades for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes. Under 2013 Regulations, the students are given a Grade Card at the end of each semester, containing the following letter grades with the Credit points as indicated.

The GPA (Grade Point Average) is given for each semester. Also, the CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given in at the end of each semester taking into account the Grades and the Credits earned by the student in the courses up to that semester (From First Semester for UG and PG).

The Final CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is given at the end of the programme taking into account the Grades and Credits earned by the students in all the courses for the 2013 and 2014 batch for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree Programmes. The overall performance of the student is indicated by the CGPA on a 10 point scale. This is approximately equivalent to CGPA multiplied by 10 on a scale of '0' to '100' marks.

The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is calculated by considering all the courses taken from the first semester onwards for regular students and from third semester onwards for lateral entry students.
