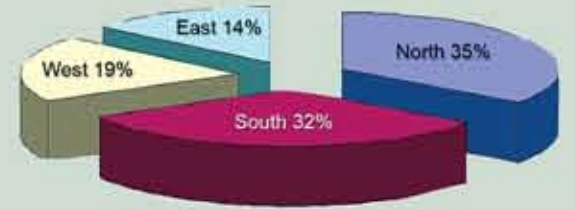
An Education Times – GfK-Mode Study



SAMPLE SIZE

In the early part of January, representatives of GfK-Mode got on the field and began their research. Of the 225 universities contacted, as many as 136 participated. The survey ended in the last week of March and the findings were suitably compiled.

RANKING PARAMETERS

The many factors that went into the ranking of the universities were:

1. General information and size of the university
2. Student community
3. Faculty resources
4. Academics
5. Facilities
6. International exposure
7. Career opportunities
8. Infrastructure
9. Social and environmental responsibilities

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

The target respondents of this survey were the administrative heads or registrars of the universities. Each of them had to answer a comprehensive questionnaire that comprised of nine sections that touched upon the many factors of the university. For each question, a score (range 1-5) was allotted following which a total score was obtained for each section.

Thereafter, weightages were assigned to each of the nine factors depending on its importance. To lend the weightage an authenticity, experienced academicians and professors outside the purview of this research, were roped in. The total score following the weightage accrued by each university ultimately determined the final rankings.

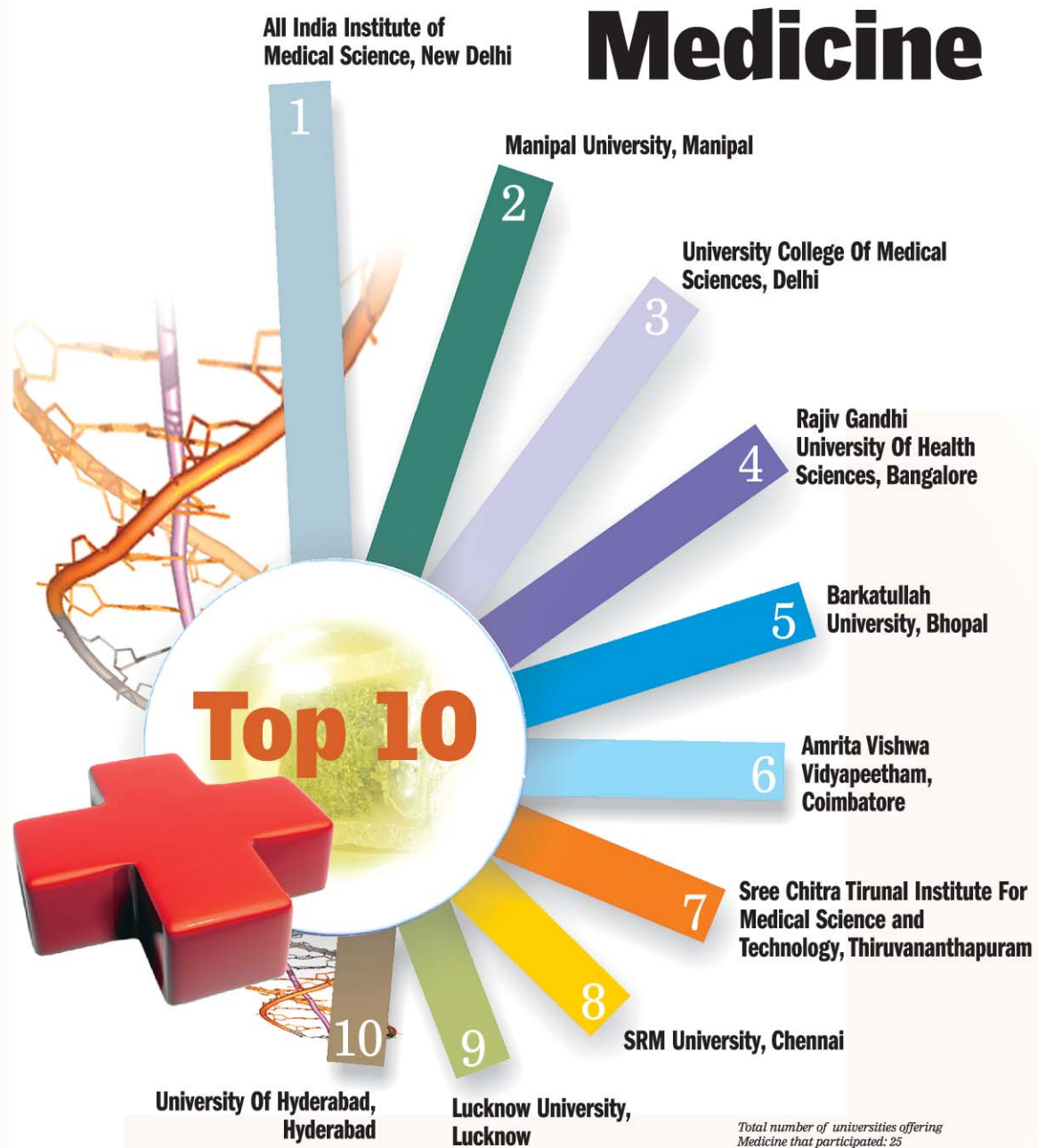

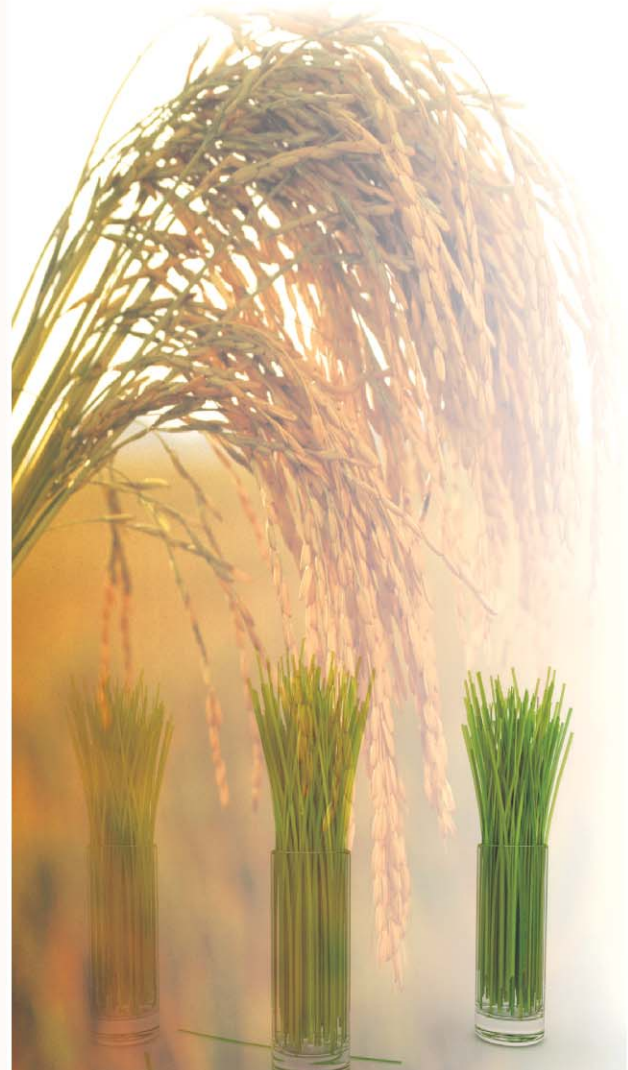

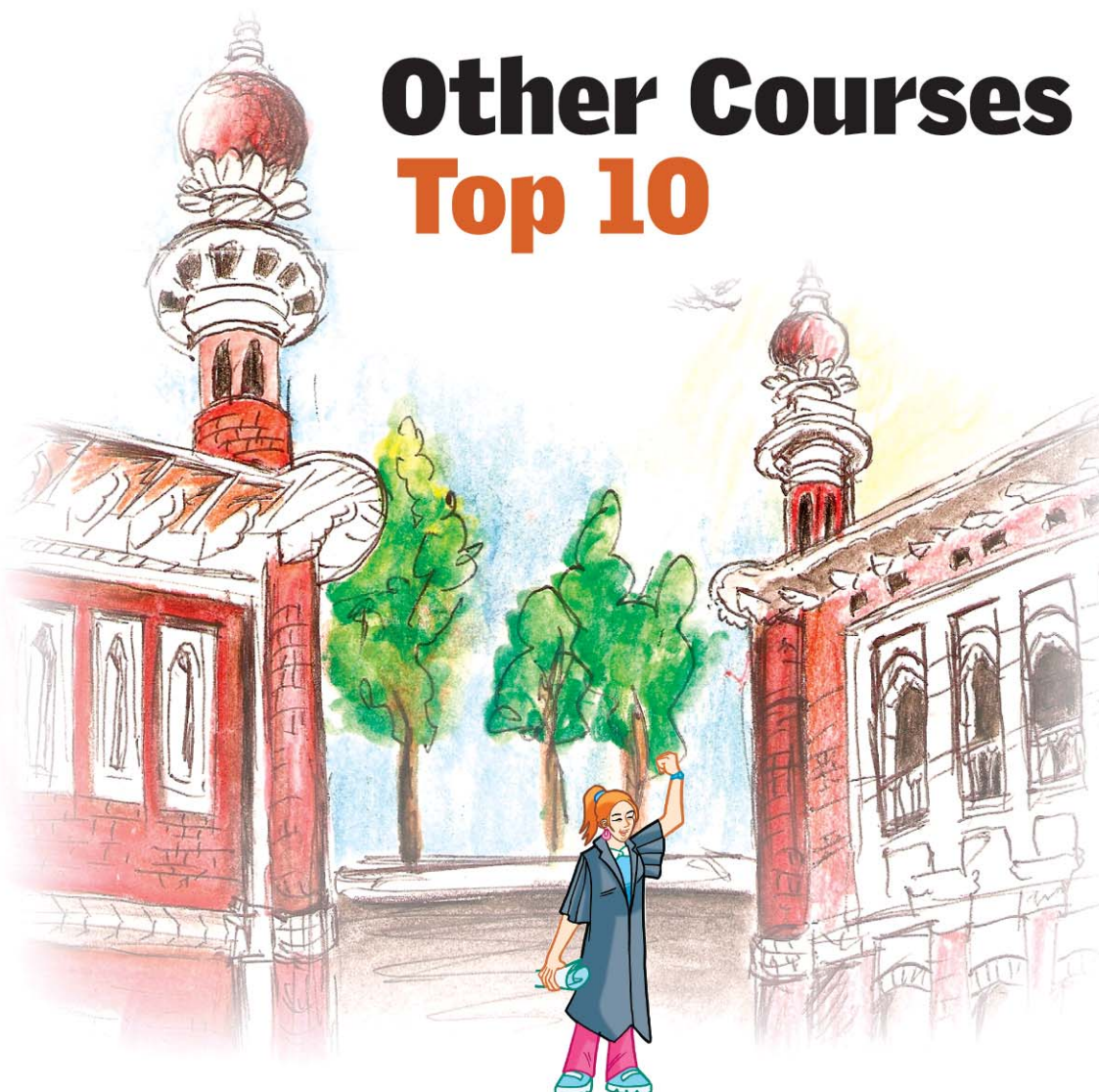
